Brazilian firm [Barbosa Müssnich & Aragão](#) has elected four new partners.

The promotions include two corporate associates, a dispute resolution lawyer and a specialist in administrative law and concessions.

As the sole partner in administrative law and concessions, Álvaro Jorge says his goal is to "help clients develop infrastructure projects, using my particular knowledge of governmental constraints and particularities."

Harvard-educated Jorge, 35, joined Barbosa in 2001 from the National Health Agency, where he managed a litigation team.

Barbosa's corporate group now boasts 15 partners with the promotion of Daniella Reali Fragoso and Fabiana Fagundes. Fragoso, 33, joined Barbosa in 2000 after working as an associate at [Levy & Salomão Advogados](#) and [Machado, Meyer, Sendacz e Opice Advogados](#).

Litigation specialist Sergio Fagundes, 38, is one of three partners driving Barbosa's dispute resolution group. He also joined the firm in 2000.
