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Brazil's Senate approves the Directors appointed to the National Data Protection Authority

On October 20th, the Federal Senate approved the Directors appointed by the President of Brazil to compose the first Board of Directors of the National Data Protection Authority (ANPD – Autoridade Nacional de Proteção de Dados).

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Proposed new Framework Legislation for Startups
