The survey, published by Who's Who Legal, recognizes the work done by BMA Inspiração over the course of 2020, amounting to 3391 hours dedicated to pro bono causes. The publication also highlights our role as pro bono legal advisers in the project involving donations of funds to adapt the production and quality control sectors of the Instituto Bio-Manguinhos manufacturing facility, which belongs to the Fundação Oswaldo Cruz (Fiocruz), for production of a vaccine against covid-19.
