BMA was once again featured in **Análise Advocacia Mulher 2026**, a segment of the annual Análise Advocacia survey that recognizes female lawyers for their work across different legal specialties and economic sectors.

This year, **23 BMA lawyers were recognized, totaling 112 individual mentions**, distributed across **14 specialties, 24 economic sectors**, and two states: Rio de Janeiro and São Paulo.

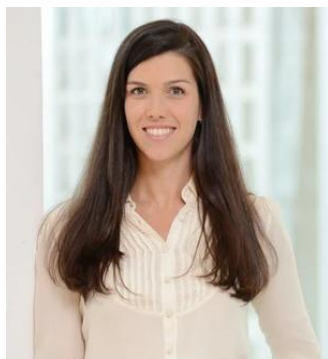
